70 years of hockey at Fremantle

Turnover Exceeds 120k

The traditional club night immediately prior to the first match was held on April 10. Following training the first part of the AGM featured the presentation of a budget for the coming year which predicted a turnover of around \$120,000. John van Heerwaarden's explanation of the detailed figures included a statement that such a turnover could have GST implications in the future.
