Tax- Deductible Donations

The total cost of the Lakelands Turf and Relocation Project is currently estimated to be \$6.5 million. Fremantle Hockey Club has magnificent support from the City of Cockburn and the State Government but it has still made a very challenging commitment to contribute \$500,000.

When making your personal donation, be sure that you specify that you would like it to go to the 'Fremantle Hockey Club Lakelands Turf Project'. ASF collect the donations on our behalf, deduct their commission and return the money to FHC by way of a grant every two months.

Donate before 30 June 2017 and then again for the next two financial years. Donations over \$2 are tax deductible. The club needs to make its full contribution to the project by around December 2018.
